



VALLEY OF FLOWERS

The trek to valley of flowers passes through thick forests, glacier and waterfalls on the way, along with Pushpawati River. Until 1931, the presence of this awe-inspiring valley was unknown to the world. Three British mountaineers Frank S. Smythe, Eric Shipton, and R.L. Holdsworth while returning from an outstanding expedition of Mt. Kamet stumbled upon this fascinating valley full with blooming flowers. Captivated by the astonishing beauty of this place, they named it as the 'Valley of Flowers'. Later on, Frank S. Smythe also wrote a book about this valley with the same title.

Hemkund Sahib

The Sikhs started to search for Hemkunt sahib, the "Tap Asthan" (the place of meditation) of their tenth Guru, in the late nineteenth century. The first Sikh to trace the geographical location of Hemkund was Pandit Tara Singh Narotam in 1884. The Gurudwara is situated at an altitude of 15,200 ft above sea level and is considered to be one of the highest Pilgrimage in the worl











Rishikesh to Joshimath

- Travel: Early morning departure to Joshimath (approx. 290 km, 10-11 hours).
- En route: Visit Devprayag, Rudraprayag, and Karnaprayag (confluences of rivers).
- Check-in: Arrive in Joshimath and check into your hotel.
- Overnight: Stay in Joshimath







Joshimath to Govindghat and Trek to Ghangaria

- Travel: Drive to Govindghat (approx. 22 km, 1 hour).
- Trek: Start the trek from Govindghat to Ghangaria (approx. 13 km, 5-6 hours).
- Check-in: Arrive in Ghangaria and check into your hotel or guest house.
- Overnight: Stay in Ghangaria.








Ghangaria to Valley of Flowers

- Trek: Start early morning trek to Valley of Flowers (approx. 4 km one way).
- Explore: Spend the day exploring the valley, enjoying the stunning array of flowers, streams, and scenic views.
- Return: Trek back to Ghangaria.
- Overnight: Stay in Ghangaria.







Ghangaria to Hemkund Sahib

- Trek: Early morning trek to Hemkund Sahib (approx. 6 km one way).
- Visit: Visit the Hemkund Sahib Gurudwara and enjoy the serene Hemkund Lake.
- Return: Trek back to Ghangaria.
- Overnight: Stay in Ghangaria








Ghangaria to Govindghat and Travel to Joshimath

- Trek: Trek back to Govindghat.
- Travel: Drive back to Joshimath.
- Check-in: Arrive and check into your hotel.
- Relax: Evening free to relax and explore Joshimath.
- Overnight: Stay in Joshimath







Joshimath to Rishikesh

- Travel: Depart for Rishikesh (approx. 290 km, 10-11 hours).
- Transfer to railway station for onward journey

VALLEY OF FLOWERS

Location:

Situated in the Chamoli district of Uttarakhand, India. Part of the Nanda Devi Biosphere Reserve.

Altitude:

Ranges from 3,200 to 3,600 meters (10,500 to 11,800 feet) above sea level.

Best Time to Visit:

Mid-July to mid-August, when the flowers are in full bloom. The park is open from June to October.

Flora:

Known for its diverse range of flora including endemic species and medicinalplants.

Notable flowers include Blue Poppy, Cobra Lily, and Brahma Kamal

Trek Distance:

Govindghat to Ghangaria: Approx. 13 km (8 miles) trek. Ghangaria to Valley of Flowers: Approx. 4 km (2.5 miles) one way.

Difficulty Level:

Moderate; suitable for trekkers with reasonable fitness levels.

Permits:

Required and can be obtained at the park entrance in Ghangaria.

Charges for Indian and foreign nationals vary



Hemkund Sahib

Location:

Situated near the Valley of Flowers in the Chamoli district of Uttarakhand, India.

Located at an altitude of 4,632 meters (15,197 feet).

Religious Significance

A Sikh Gurudwara dedicated to Guru Gobind Singh, the 10th Sikh Guru.

Also revered by Hindus as a place where Lakshmana, brother of Rama, meditated.

Best Time to Visit:

June to October, with August and September being the peak pilgrimage season.

Trek Distance:

Ghangaria to Hemkund Sahib: Approx. 6 km (3.7 miles) one way.

Difficulty Level:

Strenuous; the trek involves a steep climb and requires good physical fitness.


Lake:

Hemkund (Lake of Snow) is a glacial lake located next to the Gurudwara.

Surrounded by seven mountain peaks, each adorned with a Nishan Sahib (Sikh flag).

Accommodation:

Basic lodging and food are available in Ghangaria.
Pilgrims can stay in the Gurudwara's dormitories in Ghangaria.





Trek Inclusion

- Transport support from Rishikesh to Rishikesh
- All vegetarian meals starting from dinner on day 1 to breakfast on the last day
- Hotel accommodation throughout the trek on a Quad sharing basis
- Professional guide, cook and support staff
- Forest entry charges for Indian nationals
- All Tolls and tax

Trek Exclusions

- Personal expenses like tips, personal medicines, phone calls etc.
- Any transport support during the trek apart from what is included above
- Any cost or services not mentioned in the Inclusions
- Cost arising due to unforeseen incidents like bad weather, medical evacuation, road blocks etc
- Porter/mule charges to carry personal luggage can be arranged at an additional cost


















Notice:
